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Dear Parents,

Each school year we are fortunate to have speech/language and occupational therapy professionals, with whom the Dwight-Englewood School has had long-standing working relationships, conduct brief and preliminary screenings of our Lower School students enrolled in preschool 3 through grade 5.

These preliminary screenings yield information about a child's developmental progress in both areas. The results of the screenings seek to ensure that both parents and teachers have additional information about the child's developmental profile. The results also provide strategies that seek to further support the child's success.

Presently, Dr. Chaye Lamm Warburg, occupational therapist and director of Pediatric Occupational Therapy Services (POTS), LLC, located in Teaneck, NJ, conducts the occupational therapy screenings. Ms. Jill Sendick, a licensed speech and language pathologist in Bergen County, NJ, conducts the speech/language screenings.

Screenings for the current school year will take place during the school day beginning on November 18, 2019. Each screening lasts for approximately 15 minutes and is conducted at times that are least disruptive to the child's day. Results of the screenings are shared with Dr. Penina Bukiet and then disseminated to families.
