MATH TEAM - GRADES 3, 4, AND 5 UPDATES:

Math team is a place for personal practice and cooperative problem-solving. It is also a place where we value diversity of thought, discipline and hard work. Using problem sets developed by the Continental Math League, we practice working hard through challenging problems and becoming comfortable when we don't get all the answers correct quickly or the first time we attempt them.

Math Team is open to 3rd, 4th and 5th graders who are willing to work hard! This year, in order to observe COVID protocols, Math Team has been offered in cycles. The cycles have allowed us to maintain safe numbers of students in our classrooms. As we begin the next set of cycles, priority will be given to students who were "waitlisted" for the first cycle.

5th Grade - Cycle 1 for 5th grade Math team will end today. There are a few slots available for Cycle 2 which will begin on Tuesday, January 4 until February 22, 2022. Priority will be given to students who were "waitlisted" for the first cycle.
