#### **Welcome Picnic**

This is an opportunity for Lower School families to meet each other and have a giant "playdate" on our campus. Bring a blanket and some food and enjoy the opportunity to build community and watch your children play! To make it easier to find your child's classmates, plan on choosing the location below that makes the most sense for your family. For families who have multiple children within the division, choose a spot to start at:

Preschool 3, Preschool 4 and K Families- Rocky's Field (This is the fenced in field that you first see when coming down the road.)

1st and 2nd Grade Families- Courtyard Playground (This is the new playground that is visible from the blue bridge.)

3rd-4th Grade Families- "Purple Playground" (This is the playground that is closest to the Swartley building.)

5th Grade Families- The hill next to the Campus Center, near "Purple Playground."

If the weather looks like it is not cooperating, we will send a communication to families by 9 am on Sunday.

Please keep an eye on your children and accompany them if they need to use bathrooms located in the building. Drapkin Hall, Swartley and Campus Center will be open for bathroom use only.

#### **Morning Arrival**

Students may be dropped off any time after 7:30 a.m. If a student arrives before 7:30 a.m., their parent or caregiver must remain with them until the doors are opened. Please remember to drive slowly on the roadway coming down to the Lower School building. Children are expected to be in their classrooms ready to begin the day at 8:20 a.m. We ask parents to make every effort to have their child arrive to school on time.

Any student in grades 3-5 who are not in their classroom ready to begin their day at 8:20 a.m. will have to sign the late list which is located at Ms. Bryan's desk. Preschool -2<sup>nd</sup> grade students who arrive late to school should be escorted into the building. Also, it is not necessary to use SchoolPass for arrivals; we are using this system for dismissals only.

#### **Afternoon Dismissal**

To avoid long car lines at dismissal, it is very important for parents to enter the queue only at the dismissal time for their child. Early arrivals slow dismissal to a stop. We will make sure that your child is available at the designated dismissal times. Parents who arrive before their child's dismissal time may be asked to leave the line and return at the correct time. Please also remember to use your car visor name sign.

Preschool 3 & Preschool 4: 2:30 pm

Kindergarten: 2:45 pm

1st Grade - 5th Grade: 3:00 pm\*\* (please see note below)

- Siblings in different grades in Lower School: after 3:00 pm
- Siblings in different grades that are in the Middle or Upper school: 3:25 pm

\*\*Students in 1st-5th grade end their classes at 2:55 so they are unable to leave school until 3:00pm. If you have students in these grades, please join the car line at 3:00 pm at the earliest. The window for Lower School dismissal is 3:00 pm-3:25 pm so you may come anytime throughout that block.

#### Communication

We will continue to communicate with Lower School parents in two formats:

- The first will be *Just the Facts*, which will be just that. It will include dates of upcoming events in the Lower School and important information for parents.
- The second will be Lower School Notes, a link which will be pushed to parents. It will
  also have detailed information about what students are doing, supported by photos and
