NURSES NOTE

Spring pollen has arrived, and with that, so have allergies. If your child takes allergy medicine for spring allergies, please be on alert for symptoms so that you may start their daily dose. Their daily antihistamine usually works best when taken at night, so that they are ready to go in the morning. Additionally, if your child is bothered by itchy, red eyes, please administer their eye drops **before** they leave for school. The pollen is very high in the morning, and they will suffer throughout the day once a reaction to pollen has begun. If you find that they need eye drops administered at school, please download the "over the counter" form on your Magnus portal and have it completed by your doctor.

Remember, a physician permission/signature, as well as your own signature, is required for me to administer any medication in school--even those that do not require a prescription. Finally, if your child is newly diagnosed with asthma that is triggered by pollen, please complete the Asthma Action Plan and send in any prescribed medications in their original prescriptive box.
