New Jersey has been hard hit with the flu and flu-like illnesses. I am requesting that when you report your child absent on SchoolPass, please add your child's symptoms and what they have been diagnosed with such as ear infection, flu, etc.

The students must be without fever for 24 hours (without fever medication) before returning to school. Additionally, they must be able to eat their lunch and sustain the day. If not, they should be allowed to rest a day or two more at home.

Please do not give your child motrin or tylenol before school. It masks their fever and they end up feeling poorly once it wears off. Also, please put a few masks in your child's backpack. I do have some but often when the students ask me for one, they express that they do not like the kind I have.

Finally, please be sure to have a full change of clothes on your child's locker. As we enter spring, the playground is often wet, and I do not have any clothes in the health office.
