IMPORTANT DISMISSAL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS...

To avoid long car lines at dismissal, it is <u>very</u> important for parents to enter the queue only five minutes before the dismissal time for their child. <u>Early arrivals slow dismissal to a stop</u>. We will make sure that your child is available at the designated dismissal times. Parents who arrive significantly before their child's dismissal time may be asked to leave the line and return at the correct time. Please also remember to use your car visor name sign.

Below are the **UPDATED** dismissal times for each grade.

Early Childhood (Preschool 3, 4 and Kindergarten)	2:30 p.m.
Grades 1 through 3 (Drapkin Hall)	3:00 p.m.
Grades 4 and 5 (Umpleby Hall)	2:45 p.m.

<u>For Families with Multiple Children on Campus that have Different Dismissal Times, See</u> Below:

- Families with a student in Early Childhood and a child in first third grade: If you are picking up a child from early childhood (preschool 3, 4, and kindergarten) and a child in first through third, please come at the later 3:00 p.m. time. Early childhood students will be supervised in their classrooms until 3:00 p.m.
- Families with a student in Early Childhood Drapkin Hall and a student in Umpleby Hall:

If you have a child in early childhood (preschool 3, 4 and kindergarten) and a fourth or fifth grader in Umpleby, pick up your **Drapkin Hall student at 2:30 p.m.** and then your **Umpleby Hall student**.

- If you have a Drapkin Hall child in first, second or third grade and an Umpleby Hall child in fourth or fifth, pick up at Umpleby at 2:45 p.m. and then travel to Drapkin for the 3:00 p.m. dismissal.
- If you have a child in Drapkin Hall and Middle/Upper School, please pick up the Drapkin Hall student first and then travel to Umpleby Hall.
- If you have children in Umpleby and Middle School/Upper School, pick them up at Umpleby at or after 3:00 p.m.

If you have a combination of children that is not included here, please reach out and we will advise on the safest way to pick up your children.

And finally, if you are picking up from Umpleby please display the "Lower School/Umpleby" sign provided so that our traffic team knows where to direct your car. Thank you and drive safely!
