Please note that students who are not picked up at 4:15 will then be supervised by the ACE program in Umpleby, and a fee is applied and pick up will be at Umpleby.

Drop Off and Dismissal Safety

Please remember that your children must exit your vehicle from the right-handed (sidewalk-side) door. It is also important that you stay in your car during drop off and dismissal. Exiting your vehicle can be dangerous, and it also holds up the car line. If you need more time or need to leave your car to walk your child in, you must find a spot to park on campus. Leaving the car unattended in the drop off line outside of Drapkin Hall is not permitted. Parking either outside of Drapkin Hall or in the fire lane would make it very difficult to move cars and tend to a possible emergency, should one arise during drop off or dismissal. Thank you for your support and for helping us keep the car line safe and quick.

Dismissal Time Reminder

To avoid long car lines at dismissal, it is very important for parents to enter the queue only at the dismissal time for their child. **Early arrivals slow dismissal to a stop.** We will make sure that your child is available at the designated dismissal times. Parents who arrive significantly before their child's dismissal time may be asked to leave the line and return at the correct time. Please also remember to use your car visor name sign.
